**This intensive summer semester is a once-in-a-lifetime opportunity for PAMS students to be a part of an exciting and highly-practical real-world corporate business project, on-location in South Korea.**

**Course Details:**

- PAMS Summer Semester Advanced Corporate Project
- 3-credits, 3 weeks (1 week online, 2 weeks on-location)
- Part 1, Online - July 31st to August 4th
- Part 2, On-location - August 7th to August 18th
- Location: Woosong University, Daejeon, South Korea

This course will be hosted by Woosong University in South Korea. The professional PAMS team on location supervise, coordinate and guide the students through the busy course schedule.

Students will be responsible for their own visas, flights and transportation to Woosong University from the airport (and back again). Wherever possible, PAMS and Woosong University will provide detailed advice, support and assistance.
